Drew Weaver moved to Granite in 1981 as a teenager with his family and fell in love with its historic legacy. Working to preserve Granite's heritage, Drew was appointed to Salt Lake County's Historic Preservation commission from 2014 to 2018 as well as Sandy's Historic Preservation Committee from 2015 to present. In addition, he has been elected to multiple consecutive terms on the Granite Community Council. Professionally, for the last 35 years he has worked in the medical device industry as a product engineer, Director of Marketing, Director of Regulatory Affairs, Director of Quality Systems, and free-lance consultant.



The Wasatch and Jordan Valley Railroad was the most critical development for completing the Salt Lake Temple because it transformed an arduous 2-day journey into a 2-hour journey while exponentially multiplying the number of stones delivered. Alta

thrived for years transporting ore down the canyon by the power of gravity. This railroad ran right through our community and next to our houses. Remnants of the rail bed can still be seen today, 150 years later.
